Dear Parents and Carers

We are very much looking forward to welcoming everyone back to school on Monday 8th March 2021 and I can now confirm our re-opening plans.

Many of our plans will be familiar to you from your experience in school during last autumn term but it is important that you read this letter carefully.

Children will enjoy a full, broad and balanced curriculum when they return to school. This objective is framed within the context of maintaining stringent controls to promote health and safety and minimise the risk of transmission of COVID-19 as much as we are able to do so.

The government, supported by Public Health England, has highlighted the importance of the following controls which must always be in place to minimise transmission:

- Minimise contact with individuals who are unwell by ensuring that those who have coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms, or who have someone in their household who does, do not attend school.
- Clean hands thoroughly more often than usual.
- Ensure good respiratory hygiene by promoting the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach.
- Introduce enhanced cleaning, including cleaning frequently touched surfaces often, using standard approved products.
Wall mounted hand sanitation units are throughout the school site to enhance our hygiene practices and to minimise transmission.

Children will remain in their class cohort and will be taught in their year group designated classrooms. Furniture in classrooms remains front facing. Playtimes and lunchtimes will continue to be staggered with children given separate areas and timings so that mixing is minimised.

Children will continue to limit the amount of equipment they bring to school.

Arrival and collection times will continue to be staggered.
