Year 6 SATS Revision Club

I am inviting children to attend a SATs Revision club which will be held on Tuesday afternoons from 3:15 pm – 4:00 pm. The first session will take place on **Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> January**. The sessions will run weekly up until Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> May. The sessions will take place in the Year 6 classroom and be led by myself.

The focus of the sessions will alternate between Reading, Mathematics and SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar). During the sessions we will be using revision materials to support children’s understanding and children will be set tasks which they will then complete outside of school. This style of learning will also support children to becoming ‘secondary ready’.

Children may bring a simple snack.

It is encouraged that **all** Year 6 children attend the sessions as it is believed they will benefit from the additional support. For children who do not attend, it will be the responsibility of individual families to use the revision guides to support their child in the lead up to SATs.
