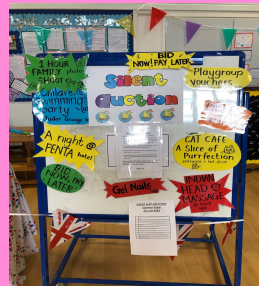
Congratulations to Joshua (KS1), Layla (KS2) & Mrs Bennett (staff) who each won prizes for selling the most Raffle Tickets.
