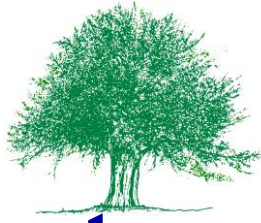

## SWIMMING

Swimming is part of the National Curriculum and all children need to participate in school swimming lessons. We have moved to George's Swim Academy because our children are more confident swimming there. This is because the venue is smaller, quieter and the instructors get into the water with the children rather than instructing from the side. Many schools have charged for swimming lessons over a number of years. We have tried to avoid this but with the significant squeeze on school budgets, we have had no choice but to ask for a small contribution. Our school needs the support of all parents to support swimming at George's Swim Academy if we are to continue using this provision.



## PARKING

Considerate, legal parking outside of school and near to our school is for our children's safety. It is absolutely essential that there is good visibility around the school exit and that pavements are not blocked forcing families to walk in the road. I respectfully wish to reiterate that safe parking is essential every day for the safety of our children, not just because a Traffic Enforcement Officer is present.



## VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

Our school works hard to request the minimum voluntary contributions from parents for enrichment activities and trips. The contributions are voluntary but without the significant majority of parents making these contributions, such activities can not go ahead and this impacts directly on our children. We ask that all parents consider making the contributions, either in full or part of it, I think this is only fair. If you do not intend to pay the voluntary contributions, please let Mrs Russell, Mrs Bloomfield or our office team know. We send reminders because we know parents can forget, as a parent myself I know this, and that they do intend to pay.
