



ONLINE SAFETY

At the beginning of this half term, we held an information evening for parents and carers about Online Safety. During this meeting, we discussed the importance of knowing how to keep your child safe online and how to be more 'digitally aware' as a parent. If you were unable to attend the meeting, the slides are available for you to access by clicking on the eSafety link on the homepage of our school website and can be found on the Parent Zone tab. Vodafone have also produced a Digital Parenting magazine, which covers a range of Online Safety information and tips to help you in this area; these will be sent home with the children next week. ATTENDANCE

We are very proud of the school's improved attendance and punctuality. We thank all of our families for working in partnership with us to achieve this. The attendance of all our statutory school aged pupils is closely monitored by Mrs Bloomfield and Mrs Nadin, who is the Attendance Officer for Tudor Grange Academies Trust. As a result of this, families will be contacted this week if your child's attendance is below 93% or if your child has been late on more than 5 occasions since September. We are striving to reduce the number of our pupils who are categorised as persistently absent. The Department for Education classifies any pupil with 90% or below as having persistent absence. The reality being 90% attendance equates to 19 missed days of education during an academic year. It is recognised statistically that low attendance can make it difficult for a child to achieve their potential. If there are any issues affecting your child's attendance that we can support you with, please do not hesitate to contact us. We will always listen and aim to help.
