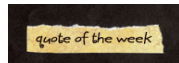
ATTENDANCE

NHS - NOROVIRUS

Norovirus, also called the 'Winter Vomiting Bug', is a stomach bug that causes vomiting and diarrhoea. It can be very unpleasant, but usually goes away in about 2 days. We have been given the following advice from the NHS:- Any pupil affected by Norovirus should not return to school until 48 hours after symptoms have passed. Ensure that your child drinks plenty of fluids, taking sips rather than gulps. Give infant Ibuprofen and/or Paracetamol according to the manufacturer's instructions. Hand washing is one of the most important ways to prevent the spread of infections. This applies to the child who is ill and person caring for them. Hands should be washed using soap and rinsed under running water and dried thoroughly. Keep a separate towel for each family member who has the symptoms and change them regularly. It is especially important that all pupils (even if they don't have the virus) wash their hands frequently and thoroughly to limit spread of infections. Dispose of used tissues immediately after use. Ensure toilet areas, baths and sinks are kept clean using hot soapy water.

Washing your hands frequently with soap and water is the best way to stop it spreading. Alcohol hand gels **do not** kill Norovirus.
