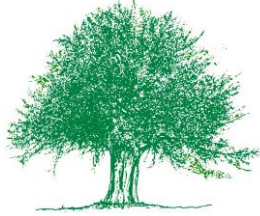

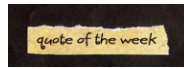
ATTENDANCE

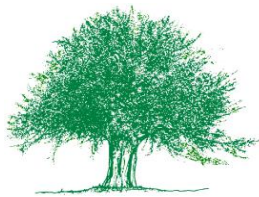

LOVE YOUR BIKE!

We are actively encouraging all of our pupils to cycle or scoot to school on Thursday 13th February 2020. As it is Valentine's Day the next day we would like the children to personalise or decorate their bike with tinsel, bells, bows and other accessories to show us how much they love their bike or scooter. They can be as imaginative or creative as you would like as long as they are safe to ride. Prizes will be awarded for the best decorated bike on Valentine's Day.

In order to prepare your child's bike for the Spring season, we will be supported by Solihull council's Sustainable Travel Team who will lead a Dr. Bike session on the same day. As part of this free session, minor issues with your child's bike or scooter can be fixed there and then. These include certain braking issues (cable replacements and realignments), puncture repairs and some gear alignment issues. They will not be able to repair serious damage but they will be happy to offer advice on the best course of action for your child's bike. Any adjustments made will be recorded on a receipt and attached to the bicycle or scooter.
