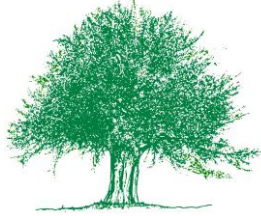

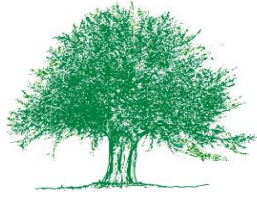

PHOTOGRAPHY AND USE OF IMAGES

The welfare and protection of our children is paramount and consideration should always be given to whether the use of photography will place our children at risk. Images may be used to harm children, for example as a preliminary to grooming or by displaying them inappropriately on the internet, particularly social networking sites. For this reason, consent is always sought when photographing children using any means, including iPads, smart phones or cameras and additional consideration given to photographing vulnerable children. Parents, carers and other spectators are requested not to take personal photographs or videos at school events, including plays, music concerts, sports days and matches. Where appropriate staff will issue a verbal reminder of this at the start of the event. The school may take photographs and videos using school equipment which can then be made available to parents, having ensured that consent has been sought before taking and using any images. This is to safeguard all the children in our school and ensure that we operate within the guidance that seeks to protect children in England, particularly around potential risks associated with sharing images of children online.
