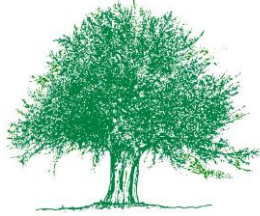

CRAFTY CORNER

Weave your own baby Turtle.

You will need 3 lollipop sticks. Using a green felt tip, colour over your lollipop sticks and glue them into place. Using different coloured wool, wrap the wool around each lollipop stick in a clockwise direction. Keep going until your weaving starts to resemble the turtle's shell. Remember to stop before you reach the end of the sticks to leave space for the turtle's legs, head and tail. Use a black felt tip to draw a face and little lines for feet.

You could swap colours as you go for a funky effect or use different shades of green to make your turtle more realistic. Have fun!
