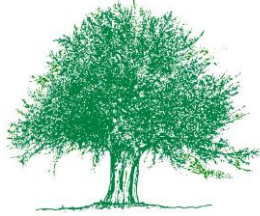

This week's word is **courageous**. Please ask your child what it means and ask them to verbalise a sentence that includes the word to deepen their understanding.



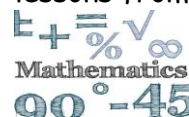
## UNIFORM FOR SEPTEMBER
