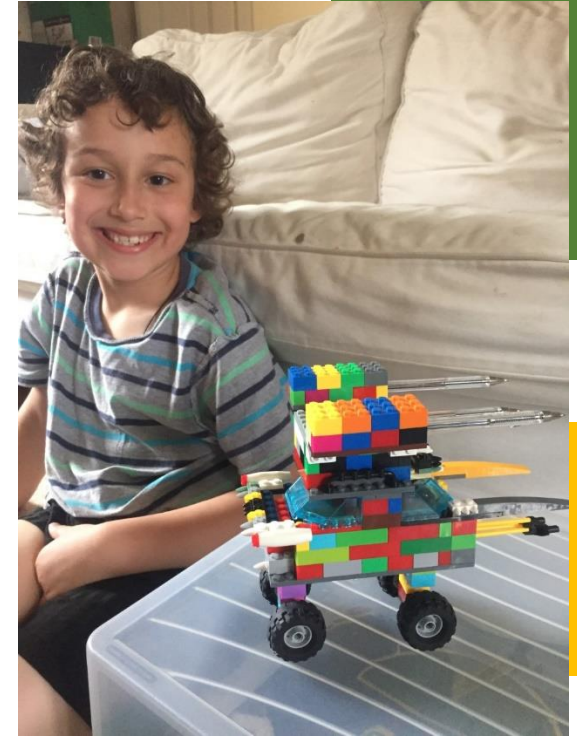




Look at all the exciting things that our school community have been reading, creating and doing whilst they are learning from home.

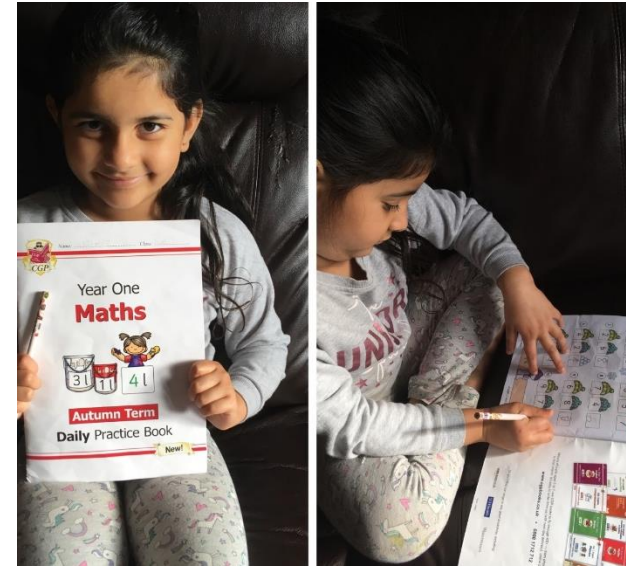




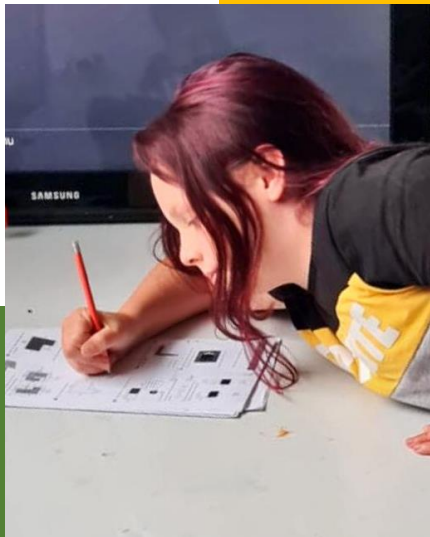
Rithwik (Yr1) created this amazing dinosaur using natural resources. He created teeth using pistachio shells.
