#### CLL: Communication, Language and Literacy

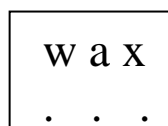
This week we have been learning the letters j, v, w, x, ch, sh, th, ng

- Use a mirror to say each letter, what happens to the shape of your mouth each time.
- Can you form these letters and your first and second name correctly.



### Maths

This week we have been counting in steps of 2. We have learnt that this pattern of numbers is called odd and even. Try using a number line to 10/20 and colour the odd numbers blue and the even numbers red. Chant the numbers and say the even numbers loudly and the odd numbers quietly. Then try saying the odd numbers loudly and the even numbers quietly.
