Be as creative as you can- maybe you can make it into a book or add illustrations to help tell your story and to show me what your creature looks like!

Challenge:

Go back over your work and make edits and up-levels in another colour. Show that you know how to improve your writing!

Think of how the particles are different in each state.</p> <p>History: now that you have an idea about what you will use for your Viking Longship model, as well as how you will do it, begin putting this together! Remember, this can be done in 2D or 3D to suit you!</p>	
18.01.2021	<p>English: begin writing your mythical creature story. You may choose to design a front cover or include illustrations! Remember to be descriptive, use a variety of punctuation and to organise your work using paragraphs!</p>
