

EYFS 79% of our pupils achieved a Good Level of Development (GLD) compared to 72% of pupils nationally.

Phonics 93% of our Year 1 pupils achieved the expected standard in the Year 1 Phonics Screen compared with 82% of pupils nationally.

Year 2 Attainment: <u>% of pupils achieving the expected standards in end of KS1 assessments;</u>

These progress measures are intended to capture the progress that pupils make from the end of KS1 to the end of primary school. As a type of value added measure, pupil's results are compared to the achievements of other pupils nationally with similar prior attainment. For all pupils nationally, the average progress score will be 0. A score of 0 means that pupils on average do approximately as well at Key Stage 2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.

A school's progress scores will be presented as positive and negative numbers either side of 0. The majority of schools will have a progress score of between -5 and +5.
