These progress measures are intended to capture the progress that pupils make from the end of KS1 to the end of primary school. As a type of value added measure, pupil's results are compared to the achievements of other pupils nationally with similar prior attainment. For all pupils nationally, the average progress score will be 0 . A score of 0 means that pupils on average do approximately as well at Key Stage 2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.

A school's progress scores will be presented as positive and negative numbers either side of 0 . The majority of schools will have a progress score of between -5 and +5 .
