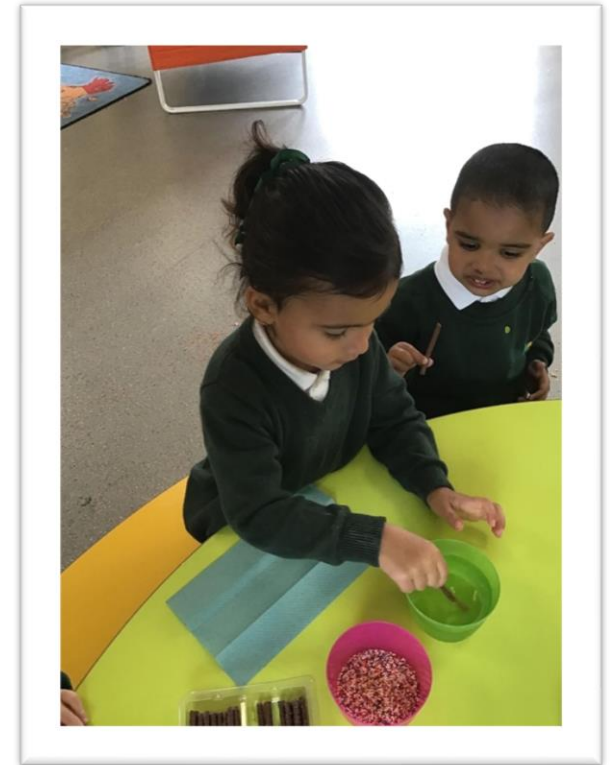

### Nursery Admissions 2023 - 2024



- From September 2023 parents are required to apply for a nursery place directly through their chosen school rather than through the council. You will have received a letter from the Family Information service team:
- **Dear colleagues, we have now completed the mail out to all families who have a child that will be age eligible for a school nursery place from September 2024. A letter has been sent for your information, which informs parents of their catchment area school and signposts them to contact schools directly to apply for a nursery place.**



Our aim at Tudor Grange Primary Academy Yew Tree is:

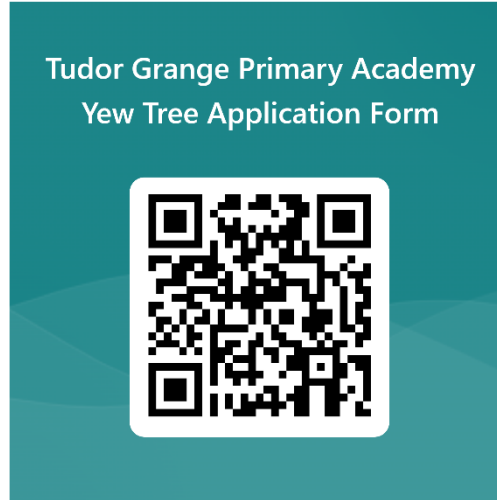
- to provide high quality learning experiences that meet the needs of each child.

We offer 30 hours

First 15 hours – Mon-Fri - mornings only (9:00 – 12:00)

Second 15 hours – Mon-Fri - all day (12 -3 :00 pm)

Making 9:00 -3:00 pm provision Monday – Friday

These admission arrangements are for pupil's entry into the School Nursery only. A Nursery place does not guarantee a place for Reception at Tudor Grange Primary Academy Yew Tree. Please see separate Admissions Policy.

If you would like to apply for a nursery place starting in September 2024 you should apply to Tudor Grange Primary Academy Yew Tree by **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2023.**

You will be notified if your child has been offered a place by

**Friday 26<sup>th</sup> January 2024.**

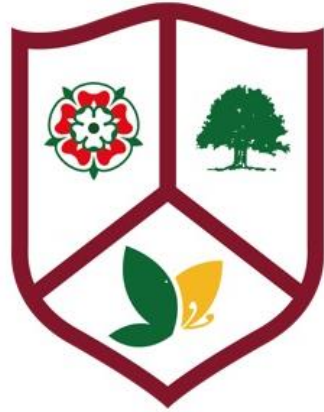

## Yew Tree Model

- Every child is entitled to 15 hours universal free early education funding hours at Yew Tree Nursery – 9:00 -12:00.
- TGAP – Yew Tree offers additional Early Education Funding for eligible families – if your family meets the nationally set eligibility criteria then your child may be able to access an additional 15 hours per week of early education – making a total of up to 30 hours per week. As soon as your child turns 3 if you are eligible they can use this funding in our settings at Yew Tree.
- Our model to deliver the additional 15 hours (if you are eligible) will be 12:00 -3:00 pm, Monday – Friday, Term Time.
- Lunch will be a charge of £2.50 for a hot dinner or you can provide a packed lunch from home. This will be payable via Parentpay.
- Once children turn 3 before 31<sup>st</sup> August it is a requirement of TGPA Yew Tree that Dragonfly children naturally move up into nursery if they are successful in obtaining a school place. If you are not successful and are placed on our waiting list only then are you able to access the Dragonfly provision. You are then able to apply for your reception school place via the Local Authority.

At Tudor Grange Primary Academy Yew Tree, Yew Tree Childcare, we offer places for your child to stay for before/ after school club.

- Afternoon sessions (Acorn class) 12:00 – 3:00pm. You can either pay (£17.00 per session including a hot lunch) or you can apply for 30 hours funding and free school meals.
