Mathematics

Place Value

- Identify one more and one less than any given number.
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations.
- Read and write numbers from 1-20 in numerals and words.

Addition and Subtraction

- Add and subtract one digit and two-digit numbers to 10.
- read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs
- represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20

English

Using the Jane Considine writing approach we will be focusing on the two texts listed below. To explore these texts, we will be using the Writing Rainbow lenses to discuss different aspects of writing that the authors have used throughout the story. This will encourage a depth of understanding throughout.

Science


The Animal Kingdom

The children will look at a range of familiar and unfamiliar British animals. They will establish some understanding that animals belong to one of six main groups: birds, fish, amphibians, reptiles, mammals, and invertebrates and that each class has different characteristics and sometimes different body parts.


 Solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction or finding the missing number.

<u>History</u>

Let's Explore

In this unit, the children will find out about the lives of Christopher Columbus, Neil Armstrong and Amelia Earhart and their explorations. They will explore some of the key experiences in their lives and discuss the reasons why they are important historical figures. The children will explore what makes someone a good explorer by considering these explorer's attributes.

<u>Geography</u>

Oceans and Continents.

In this topic, the children's learning will be focussed on the globe. Children will learn to name and identify the continents of the world and the surrounding oceans. They will also be able to identify some key facts about each continent and identify the continent we live on.

Religious education

What is the Holy Bible?

The children will learn about the Holy Bible and why it is seen as a sacred text. They will learn about the differences between the Old Testament and the New Testament and will learn some stories from the Bible.

Why do Christians celebrate Christmas?

The children will explore the Christmas story and find out about the different characters involved in the story. They will explore who Christians believe Jesus is and why they celebrate his birth at Christmas.

Physical Education

Fundamental Movement

Physical: balance, jump, hop, run, speed, agility, dodge, skip, coordination

Social: collaboration, work safely, support others

Emotional: determination, self regulation, honesty, perseverance

Thinking: comprehension, select and apply skills

Dance

Physical: actions, dynamics, space, relationships

Social: respect, work safely, collaboration, communication

Emotional: empathy, confidence, acceptance, determination, kindness

Thinking: creativity, select and apply actions, copy and repeat actions, provide feedback, recall

<u>Music</u>

Action Songs

The children will be learning different action songs and will be singing and performing them in different tempos and at different volumes.

Body Percussion

The children will be exploring and learning about rhythm through simple body percussion.

PSHE

Being Me in My World

In this unit, the children will understand their rights and responsibilities as a member of the class. They will know how their views are valued and will recognise that their choices have consequences. They will also recognise how it feels to be proud of an achievement.

Celebrating Difference

In this unit, the children will identify similarities and differences between people in the class. They will also consider how our differences make us all special and unique.

Design & Technology

Moving Pictures

The children will explore how moving pictures are used within books and greeting cards by learning about and identifying the different types of mechanisms, including sliders, pivots, and levers. Using this knowledge, the children will design, make, and evaluate their Christmas card, which will include one of the above mechanisms.

<u>Art</u>

Artist Study - Claude Monet

The children will explore the work of Claude Monet and will have the opportunity to create their own art in the style of this artist.

Computing

What is technology?

Develop your learners' understanding of technology and how it can help them. They will become more familiar with the different components of a computer by developing their keyboard and mouse skills, and also start to consider how to use technology responsibly.

Creating Media

Explore the world of digital art and its exciting range of creative tools with your learners. Empower them to create their own paintings, while getting inspiration from a range of other artists. Conclude by asking them to consider their preferences when painting with, and without, the use of digital devices.
